



Scholarship Procedures

GENERAL

A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to each of two outstanding senior musicians who are completing their high school education and planning to continue their participation in music at a regionally accredited institution of higher learning. The scholarship will be based on demonstrated proficiency at the Advanced level. The Scholarship Committee will consider academic achievement, involvement in school and community activities and a required letter of recommendation from the current music teacher.

The cutoff date for receipt of applications from candidates will be April 6, 2018. The Scholarship Committee will decide recipients by April 15 of the award year. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to make all final decisions concerning the granting of all scholarships.

ELIGIBILITY

Graduating high school seniors.

1. Overall grade point average of 3.0 and a minimum of 3.5 grade point average in all music-related courses **submitted on an official transcript.**
2. Letter of reference from current music teacher (private or school), which indicates endorsement of the student's having a suitable level of competence to aspire to a career in music.
3. Letter from the student, also signed by the parent, stating that the student has applied to a regionally accredited institution of higher learning.

APPLICANTS

In addition to fulfilling the above four eligibility requirements, in your own handwriting using black ink:

1. Please list your extra-curricular activities and community service, together with the length of time you have participated in each activity. Please have this list endorsed by an adult who has knowledge of your activities and service.
2. Are you now, or have you been, employed during the past two years? What type of work? How many hours per week?
3. Please list the music-related honors, awards, etc. that you have received.
4. What is your proposed major field of study?
5. How you plan to continue your musical activities?
